



**Oral Surgery: Need to know & Nice to know**

• Dr. Jason Chen

**Synopsis:** This lecture will address some interesting oral surgery topics, dividing them into areas you should know about and areas you might be interested in. For those doing intravenous sedation, presentation will include risk assessment, monitoring, and equipment to prevent untoward outcomes. Dentoalveolar complications will also be discussed ranging from displaced teeth and odontogenic infections to managing patients on bisphosphonates. The lecture will then focus on recent advances in dentistry including bone grafting techniques and virtual surgery. Topics will include application of Bone Morphogenic Protein and use of virtual surgery planning in implant surgery and orthognathic surgery.

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

***BCDA/CDSBC - Avoiding Complaints: Using records and communication to build professionalism and safeguard your practice.***

- Peter Stevenson-Moore, Jerome Marburg (*Registrar/Ceo*), Carmel Wiseman (*Director of Professional Regulation*) and Jocelyn Johnston

**Synopsis:** The College will be delivering our new workshop on avoiding complaints. We are informally referring to this as the CDSBC roadshow, and we intend to deliver it to several locations around the province in the 2013/14 year. In some cases we will tie in with an existing

dental society meeting (as with TODS, Northwest Dental Society and FVDS) and where that is not possible, we will plan, organize and deliver the workshop independently (as we are doing in Courtenay, Nanaimo, Prince George and Dawson Creek).

**Biographies:**

**Peter Stevenson-Moore Bio:**

Dr. Stevenson-Moore has maintained a private practice since 1978. While doing so, he has become a leader in the prevention and management of the oral complications of cancer and cancer treatment. This work has included the development of protocols for the identification of dysplastic tissue and early cancers; the prevention of the breakdown of teeth (an unfortunate risk associated with several forms of cancer treatment); and the rehabilitation of patients with complex prosthodontic defects. He was the first person to hold a position of leadership in dentistry and oral oncology in Canada, largely as a result of the significant incidence of oral complications recognized by oncologists at the BC Cancer Agency 35 years ago. His pioneering and leadership role there spanned 29 years, and has resulted in the creation of a department of oral oncology and dentistry that has set world class standards for cancer treatment and research. From its humble beginnings and under the leadership of Dr. Stevenson-Moore, the Agency now serves five, soon to be six, cancer centres in BC.

**Jerome Marburg Bio:**

Jerome is the Registrar and Chief Executive Officer of the College of Dental Surgeons of British Columbia, where he directs all administrative and operational matters, including the regulatory and policy responsibilities set out in the Health Professions Act, Regulations and Bylaws. Jerome has extensive experience as a regulator, executive manager and general counsel for professional regulatory bodies. He has a strong background in board governance, policy analysis and practical business administration.

**Carmel Wiseman Bio:**

Carmel Wiseman is the director of professional regulation at the College of Dental Surgeons of British Columbia where she oversees the College's responsibilities for regulation in the areas of professional conduct and discipline. This includes overseeing the legal and process requirements for registration, as well as complaints cases that are put forward to the Health Professions Review Board. Carmel has extensive experience in professional regulation. She spent

14 years at the Law Society of BC working in the areas of policy and legal services, professional conduct and unauthorized practice. Her more recent responsibilities included policy development in regulation and privacy. Carmel has also delivered several educational courses on the subject of self-regulating professions, and is an active member of the Women Lawyers Forum organized by the Canadian Bar Association.

**Jocelyn Johnston Bio:**

Ms. Jocelyn Johnston is the Executive Director of the British Columbia Dental Association. Jocelyn has served the profession since 1991 when she began work at the College of Dental Surgeons of BC prior to the creation of the Association in 1998. Jocelyn holds a Master's degree in Economics and is committed to serving the membership and promoting oral health for all British Columbians.

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

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
